Grants

NACD offers several grant programs for conservation districts.

Stay tuned this fall for the launch of the application periods for the Friends of NACD District Grants Program (open only to NACD members) and the Outreach and Technical Assistance Grants program.

The Historically Underserved Farmer-to-Farmer Outreach Program is also accepting applications on a rolling basis for conservation districts in parts of NACD's Southeast, South Central and Southwest Regions.

Region Meetings

Several of NACD's Regions will have in-person meetings this summer, including the Northeast Region at NACD's 2024 Summer Conservation Forum & Tours in Boston. The Pacific and Southwest Regions will meet jointly in Anchorage, Alaska during September 11-13, 2024, and the South Central Region will meet in Oklahoma on September 22-24, 2024. Many of the regions have virtual meetings on a monthly or bi-monthly basis, during which they discuss district activities, network, and share information.
